The mediator's fee is billed at an hourly rate and includes any pre-mediation preparation time and post-mediation follow-up related to the matter. Mediation fees and expenses are generally divided equally among the parties unless other arrangements are made.

The minimum fee for a half-day mediation is three hours. The minimum fee for a full-day mediation is five hours.

There are no administrative, scheduling, or rescheduling fees.
